

ADVERTISEMENT TO BID

Electronic bids will be received by the Otay Water District (District) for the **PASO DE LUZ/ TELEGRAPH CANYON AND VISTA GRANDE/VISTA SIERRA WATER LINE REPLACEMENT (CIPs P2612 & P2616)** through vendor Periscope S2G (formerly BidSync), until **4:00 P.M., local time, on Thursday, February 17, 2022**, and at that time bids will be publicly opened and read.

The general scope of work for P2612 and P2616 involves the construction of approximately 1,750 linear feet of 12-inch water line in public right-of-ways and easements, connections to existing water lines and services, removal and abandonment of existing water lines, pavement and surface restoration, traffic control, cathodic protection, and all other associated work and appurtenances in accordance with the Contract Documents. The engineer's estimate is \$2,170,000.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

- No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].
- No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

The District is using Periscope S2G (formerly BidSync), an online bid solicitation website, for electronic distribution of Bid Documents. Bidders must register online with Periscope S2G at <https://www.periscopeholdings.com/s2g> to participate in this procurement. There is no cost associated with registering. All documents and information related to this procurement are on the Periscope S2G website under the bid name "**PASO DE LUZ AND VISTA SIERRA WATER LINE REPLACEMENT (P2612&P2616)**", Bid Number FY22-3300-014. Once registered, bidders can view and download information regarding this procurement including the bid and Contract Documents as well as submit questions related to the bid and contract documents. The District will only respond to questions submitted on Periscope S2G.
